



Missouri's Show Me Healthy Women program provides FREE cancer screenings to age and income eligible Missouri residents, women who are not residents of Missouri, and women who are non U.S. citizens!\*

**1. YOU MUST MEET THE 2009-2010 INCOME GUIDELINES LISTED BELOW:**

**2. YOU MUST MEET THE AGE GUIDELINES LISTED BELOW:**

Women ages 50 to 64 or older – (not eligible for Medicare Part B)

Are eligible for a clinical breast examination (CBE), mammogram, Pap test and pelvic examination.

Breast & cervical diagnostic services are available for abnormal results.

Women ages 35 to 49 - (providing no other funding source is available)

Are eligible for a clinical breast examination (CBE), Pap test and pelvic examination.

Are eligible for diagnostic breast services if the CBE results are suspicious for cancer.

Show Me Healthy Women who are diagnosed with breast and/or cervical cancer or cervical pre-cancerous conditions are eligible for MO HealthNet Breast & Cervical Cancer Treatment (BCCT). *\* Women enrolled in BCCT must be a legal Missouri resident under 65 years of age and have a screening and/or diagnostic test paid by Show Me Healthy Women.*
